

Please appreciate that as a staff we are doing our utmost to get as many children back to school in the safest possible way.

This information is for all the parents who have confirmed that their child will be returning on the 1st June

If you have not confirmed your child will be returning you will not be able to send your children in until the 15th June. This is because we have organised the children into groups of less than 15 as per Government guidelines.

If you wish for your child to return on the 15th June, or at a later date, we ask that you give us 1 week notice to ensure we can put the necessary plans in place

Year 6 children:

- Will be in a bubble with Miss Howell, Mrs Woolley, Mrs Beech and Mrs Hartland.
- Will have their own equipment that will be cleaned regularly through the day and deep cleaned at night. They will have their own handwashing and toilet facilities.
- Should bring their own water bottle into school.
- Should bring in their own packed lunch in a disposable bag.
- Should not bring any bags, PE kits or books into school.
- Parents should not enter the school site and should drop their children (if necessary) at the bottom gate.
- Can enter school at any time from 8.30 – 9.00 am.
- Should enter through their normal entrance.
- Can be picked up at the bottom gate at 3.00pm.

Reception children:

- Will be in a bubble with Mrs Davis, Miss Lovegrove, Mrs Jones, Mrs Power and Mr Price.
- Will have their own equipment and work across three classrooms that will be cleaned regularly through the day and deep cleaned at night. They will have their own handwashing and toilet facilities.
- Should bring their own water bottle into school.
- Should not bring any bags, PE kits or books into school.
- Can have a hot dinner or they can bring a packed lunch from home. Please use the usual system for booking dinners. *If your child is having a packed lunch can you provide it in a disposable bag?*
- Parents should line up on the top playground with their children ensuring they remain 2 metres *apart this will be marked on the ground.*
- Can be brought to school between 8.30 – 9.00 am.
- Can be picked up at the usual exit between 2.45 – 3.00pm. Again, parents should line up observing the 2metres social distancing markers.

Year 1 children:

- Will be in a bubble with Mrs Mitchell, Mrs Aston, Mrs Lewis, Mrs Phillips.
- Will have their own equipment and work across three classrooms that will be cleaned regularly through the day and deep cleaned at night. They will have their own handwashing and toilet facilities.
- Should bring their own water bottle into school.
- Should not bring any bags, PE kits or books into school.
- Can have a hot dinner or they can bring a packed lunch from home. Please use the usual system for booking dinners. *If your child is having a packed lunch can you provide it in a disposable bag?*
- Parents should line up outside the classroom with their children ensuring they remain 2 metres *apart this will be marked on the ground.*
- Can be brought to school between 8.30 – 9.00 am.
- Can be picked up at the usual exit between 2.45 – 3.00pm. Again, parents should line up observing the 2metres social distancing markers.

Key Worker Children

These will now be split into 2 groups.

Year 2/3 Key Worker children:

- Will be in a bubble with Miss Simpson, Mrs Childs, Miss Sharp and Miss Upton and based in Miss Lovegrove's classroom.
- Will have their own equipment and work across three classrooms that will be cleaned regularly through the day and deep cleaned at night. They will have their own handwashing and toilet facilities.
- Should bring their own water bottle into school.
- Can have a hot dinner or they can bring a packed lunch from home. Please use the usual system for booking dinners. *If your child is having a packed lunch can you provide it in a disposable bag?*
- If parents are dropping off their children from 8.30 onwards then they should line up on the bottom playground with their children ensuring they remain 2 metres apart. *This will be marked on the ground and there will be signs informing you where to line up.*

Year 4/5 Key Worker children:

- Will be in a bubble with Mr Heath, Miss Young, Miss Mitsopolous and Mrs Durns and based in Mr Heath's classroom.
- Will have their own equipment and work across three classrooms that will be cleaned regularly through the day and deep cleaned at night. They will have their own handwashing and toilet facilities.
- Should bring their own water bottle into school.
- Can have a hot dinner or they can bring a packed lunch from home. Please use the usual system for booking dinners. *If your child is having a packed lunch can you provide it in a disposable bag?*
- If parents are dropping off their children from 8.30 onwards then they should line up on the bottom playground with their children ensuring they remain 2 metres apart. *This will be marked on the ground and there will be signs informing you where to line up.*

Breakfast Club

- **Will run from 7.45 to 8.45 am and will be for Key Worker children only.**
This includes children of key workers from all groups.
- This will be at a cost of £2 per child. *The reason for the charging is that we will now be paying staff to prepare and make food.*
- Your child should be dropped off at the main entrance from 7.45. We will be maintaining social distancing during Breakfast Club. The children will then be taken to their classroom at 8.30.

After School Club

- **Will run from 3.00 to 5.00pm and will be for Key Worker children only.**
This includes children of key workers from all groups.
- This will be at a cost of £7 per child and a reduced rate for siblings. *We would love to provide it for free as we have been doing during lockdown but the reason for the charging is that we will now be paying staff to run the club and we will be providing food.*
- We will be try to maintain social distancing during After School Club to ensure that there is no contamination between bubbles.
- Children will be provided with food and drinks during this time.
