

Symptoms and Procedures Flowchart

Symptoms include :

- *a new continuous cough,*
- *high temperature,*
- *a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia).*

If your child or any member of the household develops symptoms then please stay at home.

Step 1: Symptoms

If a child or any member of staff display symptoms in school then they will be isolated in a ventilated room. They will be looked after by a member of staff who will wear PPE.

Parents will be contacted and the children will need to be picked up immediately.

All the people (staff and children) from that bubble will be sent home to isolate until the person with symptoms has had a test and the results shared with school.



Step 2: Testing

If your child has symptoms you should book a test via: <https://www.nhs.uk/ask-for-a-coronavirus-test>

You should ring NHS 111 for any advice.



Positive test

If the results are positive then the person is in isolation with their family.

Rest of the bubble should then also be tested.

Negative test

The negative test result will need to be shown to Mr. Aiston.

Isolation will end for that bubble and everyone will return to school or work.
