

Roadmap for Summer Term 2

Phase 1: **Where we are at present**

- Rota running for vulnerable and children of key workers.
- Remote learning in place for all year groups.
- All pupils are receiving some form of contact through Facebook, e-mail or phone call to check on wellbeing and work issues.

We are offering childcare provision:

1. Providing childcare for children of critical workers
2. Children who the school believe need some in school support

Phase 2: **1st June**

- Year 6 children return to school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- Year 1 children return to school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- Reception children return to school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- The rota for key worker children will continue
- Packs and/or remote learning provided for children when they have the week out of school
- Telephone calls/ online checks continue to take place for those still in remote learning only.
- Remote learning for other year groups and for children not in school

If 2/3 or less of the children do not return we will not be splitting Year groups into Group A and Group B and will be able to have Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 in full time.

Phase 3: **15th June**

- Reassess the groups and the numbers in schools. ***Do we have the capacity to bring the children in full time? Or do we maintain the rota?***
- Year 6 children continue in school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- Year 1 children continue in school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- Reception children continue in school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- The rota for key worker children will continue
- Packs provided for children when they have the week out of school
- Telephone calls/ online checks continue to take place for those still in remote learning only.
- Remote learning for other year groups and for children not in school

Phase 4: **22nd June – 20th July** ***This is subject to guidance and capacity within school***

- Year 5, Year 4, Year 3 and Year 2 all have one week in school prior to the summer holidays.
- Year 6 children continue in school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- Year 1 children continue in school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- Reception children continue in school. Group A in week 1, Group B in week 2
- The rota for key worker children will continue

- Packs provided for children when they have the week out of school
- Telephone calls/ online checks continue to take place for those still in remote learning only.
- Remote learning for other year groups and for children not in school
