

Autumn term 2020

Bubbles

We will have 3 bubbles:

- Reception and Year 1 Bubble;
- Years 2,3 and 4 Bubble;
- Years 5 and 6 Bubble.

These will be located in three different areas of the school which will reduce the risk of children coming into contact with children from other bubbles.

Breakfast Club

This will run from 7.45 until 8.45 for everyone. The Hall will be split into 3 sections for the 3 bubbles.

Start of the day

Children will arrive from 8.45 onwards (registration closes at 9am).

Reception will use their normal area and parents are encouraged to drop their children off at the gate but they can bring their children in if it is felt that it is required.

Year 1 will use their normal gate and parents are encouraged to drop their children off at the gate but they can bring their children into the classroom if they feel it is required.

Year 2 children will enter through their external classroom door.

Year 3 and 4 children will come on the premises via the big bottom gate and enter through their external classroom doors as they do at present. We ask that parents leave the children at the school gate unless there is a reason to, for example a distressed child.

Year 5 and 6 children can enter via the big bottom gate from 8.30 but must go to the MUGA area with Mr Aiston. From 8.45 Year 5 and Year 6 children will enter through their usual entrance. We ask that Year 5 and 6 parents do not enter the premises unless there is a reason to.

End of the day

Children should be collected at 3.15pm.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 parents should wait outside the classrooms as per normal.

Year 3 and Year 4 parents are welcome to wait on the main playground.

Year 5 and Year 6 parents should wait for their children at the big bottom gate.

Breaktimes

Reception and Year 1 will have their breaktimes on the top playground

Years 2,3 and 4 will have breaktime from 10.30 – 10.45.

Years 5 and 6 will have breaktime from 10.45- 11.00am.

Lunchtimes

Reception and Year 1 11.45- 12.20 (approx) in the left handside of the hall

Year 2,3 and 4 from 12.20 in the right handside of the hall

Years 5 and 6 from 12.40 in the left handside of the hall

After School Club

This will run from 3.15 until 5.30pm. The hall will be split into 3 sections for the 3 bubbles. The bubbles may mix when they are outside but social distancing will be encouraged. Bookings should be made through school money.

Uniform and PE Kits

Full school uniform should be worn from September. The correct PE kit should be in a bag in school and be taken home to be washed at the end of the week.

Extra-Curricular Clubs

At the moment there are plans for any extra-curricular clubs in the first half term. We will be looking at this prior to September.

Educational visits

Any visits will be risk assessed from September. No visits are currently planned

Toilets

Reception and Year 1 have own toilets
All other year groups use their normal toilets.

Equipment

Equipment should remain within bubbles.
PE equipment, Cooking, D and T and Science will be thoroughly cleaned and put away.

Hygiene procedures

Children should wash their hands after being outside. Soap and water if possible; hand sanitiser if not practical. The whole school will be cleaned from 11-1pm and thoroughly cleaned every night

Assemblies

Will be carried out within the bubble. Mr Aiston will do an assembly for each bubble once a week in the hall

Visitors

We will be limiting the amount of visitors in school. All necessary visitors will be asked to provide details on arrival for test and trace purposes and will be expected to social distance as much as possible from the people in school. No volunteers will be coming into school in the first half term.
